Art club used their **imagination** this week to create 3D creative creatures.

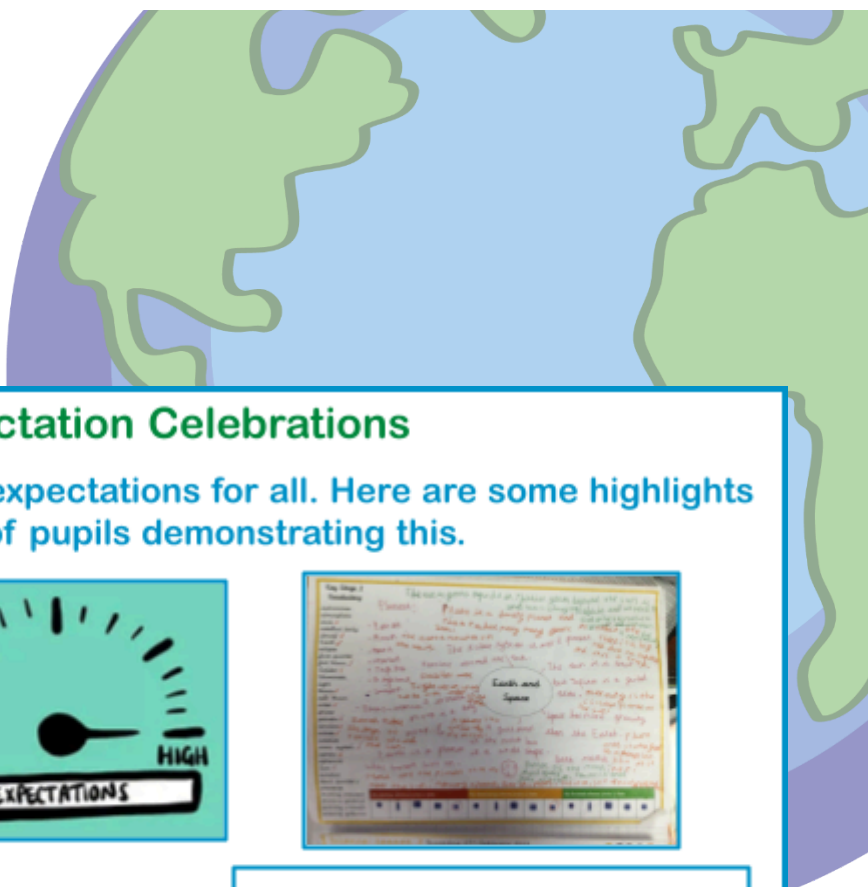
Some great **imagination** seen this week with the Easter crafts. Well done everyone who took part.



Year 4 used their **imagination** this week to create an electronic game in D&T.

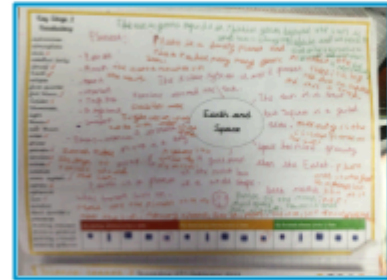
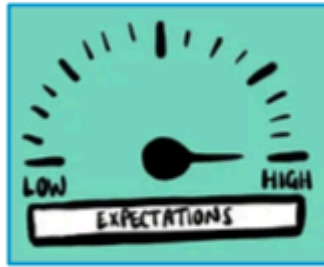

We have high expectations that pupils will reflect on their learning and link what they have learnt. This is a great example of a science schema showing all they have learnt.

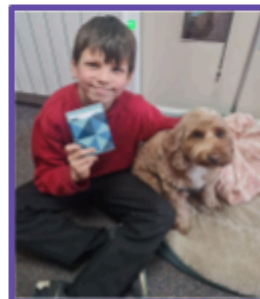
Every day Counts
