SPELLING AT CHILTERN

Foundation 2 will begin receiving spellings in the second half of the summer term. Foundation 2 and Year 1 spelling words are linked to the phonics sounds covered in previous phonic sessions.

Years 2 - 6 spelling words are linked to the weekly spelling patterns taught in class and builds upon phonic skills previously taught, which refer to the class phoneme chart. Years 1 to 6 will also receive common exception words. Every year group will have at least two opportunities to practise common exception words within the tests throughout the year. Spellings will be taught at the beginning of the week, investigating spelling patterns, syllables, root words etc with the children. The spellings will then be practised using spelling dice, pick a pair and gamification. This will help secure the spelling patterns and common exception words to memory using the look, cover, write say and check method. The spellings will also be incorporated into activities such as handwriting and dictation activities to ensure children have sufficient practise.

Look, Cover, Write and Check

The children can also write spellings in their spelling books. The book provides space for every child to practise writing the words using the pattern 'look, cover, write and check'. Children fold the book into columns for this to happen. They can also use words on flash cards to take home, create games such as pick a pair, taking a photo at the right side of the brain, verbalising the spelling and also develop a joined script with phonemes that are easy to join to aid muscle memory.
